- Supporting team members in executing theme-based program in a fast a paced environment for campers aged 4-16.
- Ensure camp counsellors carry out theme-based activities.

- Assemble / organize supplies and equipment required for camp.
- Demonstrate best practices for role model behaviour.
- Instruct groups and individuals in arts, crafts and sports activities.
- Communicate with caregivers of program participants.
- Ensure safety of all participants and provide first aid when required.
- Enforce safety rules and regulations.
- Supervise camp counsellors at main and offsite locations.
- Maintain strong communication via phone, email and in person with supervisors and staff.
- Provide support with behaviour management and emergencies.
- Assist Recreation Programmer in creating camp programs and training.
- Spend three weeks offsite at various locations in the Township of Ramara, and be responsible for any two staff offsite.

Qualifications / Skills

- Minimum 1-2 years previous experience in a camp setting;
- Strong behaviour management skills;
- Must have reliable transportation to the worksites;
- Must be willing and available to work the entire summer- contract required to be signed;
- Attendance at training sessions prior to camp is MANDATORY;
- Current Criminal Reference Check with Vulnerable Sector Screening will be required as well as current CPR-C and First Aid (or willing to obtain at own expense);
- Certification in HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development from HIGH FIVE® National. (or if hired, must obtain by July 2, 2025);
- Behaviour Management Systems and/or Non-Violent Crisis Intervention training (or if hired, must obtain by July 2, 2025);
- Excellent interpersonal and customer service skills;
- Ability to schedule activities, keep logs, maintain records and prepare reports;
- Applicants must be available from May August.
