NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY

BAYSHORE VILLAGE EFFLUENT SPRAY IRRIGATION SYSTEM

The Township of Ramara has undertaken a Class Environmental Assessment study (Class EA) – Schedule B to find the most appropriate solution for the disposal of the effluent from the Bayshore Village sewage treatment lagoons. Currently, treated effluent from the sewage lagoons is spray irrigated on two fields near Concession Road 8 and Sideroad 20. Alternative approaches for effluent disposal were considered due to the deterioration of the spray irrigation fields' infiltrative capacity over time, which is resulting in operational issues with the disposal of the effluent during the allowed spray irrigation period.

The study has been carried out in accordance with the planning and design process for a Schedule B project as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015).

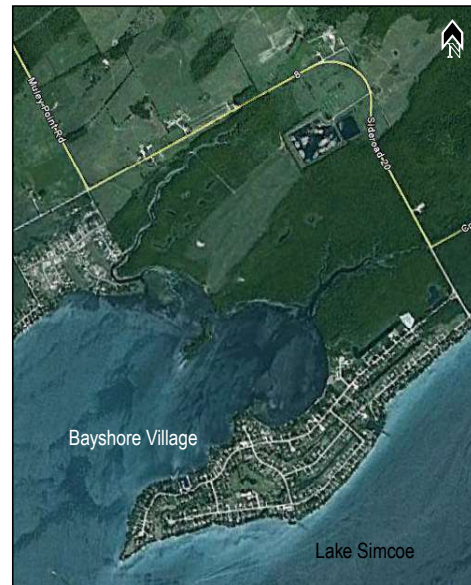
The Class EA study has concluded the preferred approach is two-phased:

- Short-term: Establish an additional spray irrigation field to provide spare capacity to allow a reduction in spray irrigation rate and frequency.
- Long-term: Discontinue spray irrigation and upgrade the sewage works with a tertiary treatment facility to reduce phosphorus and disinfect the effluent, and discharge to Wainman's Creek.

A Class EA Phases 1 and 2 Project File Report has been prepared to document the Class EA study. The report is available for review on the Township of Ramara website (www.ramara.ca) and at the Township of Ramara Administration Office, 2297 Highway 12 in Brechin.
